Condition of Entry

Competitors & persons entering grounds do so at their own risk. All competitors must be a financial member of a Pony Club affiliated with the PCA of NSW. Property Identification Code (PIC) is to be supplied for all horses entering the grounds. Pony club rules will apply in all events, full uniform. Led & Beginner riders not eligible for champion. Led riders must be led from the shoulder by a PC member over 17 years. Beginner riders must only walk and trot. Judges decision is final. Ring program may be altered at the discretion of the committee if numbers permit. **STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED**

Definition of Utility Station Hack

In the Utility Station Hack class, the Judge is looking for a horse that a station hand would use around a station or property. The horse should be able to work stock and allow the rider to carry a raincoat, jump a small obstacle.

The horse should have athletic ability, an excellent temperament and be able to complete the activities in a relaxed and calm manner. The horse should be able to walk at a good pace on a light rein in competition. The pattern could include: walk, trot, canter, gallop, lead changes, stop and back up. The following items may be included in the working pattern: gate, raincoat, small jump. The judge may request part of the pattern to be ridden one handed.
