JUMPING:

All Combinations must be Zone Jump Graded- no cards no jump

► **Show Jump – AM7** – risen round- Juniors A,B,C,D,E, Associates A,B,C,D. Combinations must be Zone Graded.

No card no jump. Official Zone Jump Card to be presented upon registration.

► **Sporting Events -** as per rider age groups- girls & boys combined

Prize for fastest time in each sporting event (all age groups combined)

Barrel Race, Washington Pole, Schudda Ho, Running Tee

► **Conditions of Entry**

- > All members please adhere to DPI Bio Security regulations/precautions for Hendra management.
- > Competitors and all persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk
- > All competitors must be financial and affiliated members for 2015 with Pony Club Association of NSW.
- > The day is to be conducted under PCANSW rules. Full Pony Club Uniform to be worn.
- > Led rider to remain on lead all day & be led at the shoulder by an affiliated member over 17yrs of age.
- > No dogs allowed on Pony Club grounds.
- > Beginner Riders not permitted to canter-walk & trot only-elimination may occur if cantering.
- > Led rider ribbon allocation may be assorted placings.
- > One horse, one rider. Judges decision is final in all events. Events/age groups/programme may be altered at organisers discretion.
- > Entry into events is deemed to be acceptance of these conditions.
- > **Zero Tolerance Policy in place.** Neglecting to adhere to this policy may result in disqualification of rider, and/or removal of offenders from the venue and competition.. **PCANSW Code of Conduct will be in force and is to be observed at all times.**
- > No prams or spectators permitted on grounds in main arenas – thankyou.
