The trophy will be retained by the winning zone for 12 months and will be engraved with the name of each team member.

In the event of a tie, a count back as per PCA NSW rules will determine the winning team.

RIDERS. Each rider must be a full financial member of PCA. Full PC uniform must be worn

TEAM MANAGER. Each rider/club must nominate a Team Manager. Team Manager is responsible for Club Gear Check, collection and return of all back numbers. Random gear checks will be performed.

WORKER. Each rider must nominate a worker. The worker will be rostered to help in the running of events.

JUMP GRADE. Each horse/rider combination will remain in the same grade, as per zone jumping card. Original jump cards must be produced when collecting back numbers. All D & E Grades run on optimum time. Pony Club heights adhered to. NO CARD NO JUMP

NON COMPETITIVE JUMP. As per the PCA NSW State Meeting March 2015, "riders (graded C or above) may be permitted to participate on two horses. (One horse competitively, the other non-competitively)." The non-competitive horse/rider combination must be club graded with card supplied.

HENDRA. Hendra vaccination is **NOT** compulsory. However, the owner must take responsibility for any sick or injured horse. Any horse noted to be sick or injured will be expelled from the championships.

PROTESTS. Are to be lodged in writing within 20 minutes of event finish. A deposit of \$20 to the Secretary is required.

WALKING THE COURSE. The course will be walked from 8.30am Saturday & 8.00am Sunday. Jumping to commence at 9.00am & 8.30am respectively. Helmets to be worn whilst walking the course.

ENTRY FEE. Entry fee includes ground levy.

CAMPING. It is expected that each entrant will respect and clean up both camp sites and stables before leaving.
