Condition of Entry

1. Competitors & persons entering grounds do so at their own risk.
2. All competitors must be a financial member of a Pony Club affiliated with the PCA of NSW.
3. Pony club rules will apply in all events, full uniform.
4. One Horse, one rider applies to all competitors
5. Age of Rider is their age on day of competition
6. Led & Beginner riders not eligible for champion.
7. Led riders must be led from the shoulder by a PC member over 17 years.
8. Beginner riders must only walk and trot, no cantering.
9. Judges decision is final.
10. Ribbons to Sixth Place
11. Program may be altered at the discretion of the committee
12. Canteen Operating
13. STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED

All horses must have current jump grading card – card must be handed in with nominations



Working Horse Pattern



Trot out
Hand gallop (canter for those who can't hand gallop)
Canter
Trot
Walk
Halt
Rein back 3 steps
Walk out of the ring on a loose rein
